## Enalapril and Hydrochlorothiazide tablet

### What is this medicine?

ENALAPRIL; HYDROCHLOROTHIAZIDE is a combination of of a diuretic and an ACE inhibitor. It is used to treat high blood pressure.

### What should I tell my health care provider before I take this medicine?

They need to know if you have any of these conditions:

- bone marrow disease
- decreased urine
- heart or blood vessel disease
- if you are on a special diet, such as a low salt diet
- immune system disease, like lupus
- kidney disease
- liver disease
- low blood pressure
- previous swelling of the tongue, face, or lips with difficulty breathing, difficulty swallowing, hoarseness, or tightening of the throat
- recent heart attack or stroke
- an unusual or allergic reaction to enalapril, hydrochlorothiazide, sulfa drugs, other medicines, insect venom, foods, dyes, or preservatives
- pregnant or trying to get pregnant
- breast-feeding
