


I'm human





Rebecca Yarros had an exciting announcement last year when she released a special edition of Fourth Wing with two bonus chapters from Xaden's perspective. The chapters are 9 and 16. Readers who haven't experienced the thrill of Fourth Wing and Iron Flame are advised to do so beforehand, as this post contains plenty of spoilers! We're diving into these specific chapters because Rebecca had to be careful not to give away any spoilers from Iron Flame. Imagine being presented with a scene where it's clear that Xaden is indeed an intuitive - a concept that was left ambiguous in the main story. In Chapter 9, Violet is called out by Xaden Riorson during a sparring session. This intimate moment is filled with tension and leaves us wondering if he'll make a move. The conversation between them is electrifying, especially when Xaden refers to Violet as "Violence." We learn more about why this nickname resonates with him in the bonus chapter. The bonus chapters offer readers a chance to explore Xaden's feelings for Violet. Chapter 9 gives us insight into her attraction to him, while the bonus chapter allows us to truly understand his perspective. It's no surprise that these moments are "pretty glorious." We get answers to some of our burning questions, such as why he was careful with her and whether he deliberately fell when she kicked the back of his knees. One interesting aspect is how Sgaeyl communicates with Xaden through their connection. This scene showcases Xaden's incredible abilities as a powerful rider. We also catch a glimpse into Xaden's thoughts about Violet's past interactions, including her encounter with Tairn and her second signet. The bonus chapters are full of memorable quotes from Fourth Wing, and we get to see Xaden's perspective on some of these moments. His reactions to Violet's words and actions add depth to their relationship. In Chapter 16, we learn more about Violet's connection to Xaden and the revelation that Tairn and Sgaeyl are a mated pair. One pivotal moment in Chapter 16 is when Dain accuses Xaden of manipulating threshing, leading to an awkward confrontation between Violet and Dain. We get to see how Xaden reacts to this tense situation, which sets the stage for some interesting developments in their story. Xaden's thoughts on Dain are now revealed, bringing immense satisfaction. Moreover, it's exciting to learn that Xaden describes Violet as "a pint-size morsel of straight-up arsenic", which is quickly becoming a favorite way to describe her. Additionally, we gain more insight into Sgaeyl's conversations, making the dragons an integral part of the book's charm. The question remains: Did Xaden move during Threshing? Or did he try to save Violet? Fortunately, Xaden provides answers, with Sgaeyl offering additional explanations. Furthermore, Xaden refers to Tairn as "one surly motherfucker", which accurately reflects his personality. Chapter 16 primarily explores what Xaden thinks of Violet, which is now well-established that he has strong feelings for her. Seeing him jealous also adds a new layer to his character, making him more relatable and human. The highlight of the chapter is learning more about Xaden's conversations with Sgaeyl, providing valuable insight into their relationship dynamics. It's fascinating to gain a glimpse into how they interact with each other. An intriguing aspect that stood out was the realization that Violet already refers to Xaden as something related to Dunne. In his POV, we learn that "if Amari herself ever designed a woman with my downfall in mind...", which raises questions about the connection between Violet and Amari's intentions. The chapter also reveals how Xaden perceives the bond between him and Violet. The color of their relationship is glorious! To top it all off, Chapter 16 features Dain kissing Violet, prompting Xaden to react with jealousy. In his special edition bonus POV, we find out what he thinks about this development: "Dain-fucking-Aetos has his mouth on my Violence." This revelation left the reader screaming in excitement. The conclusion left me underwhelmed, as the moment felt flat and lacked depth. It was meant to be impactful, but instead, it failed to add much to the story. The repetition of phrases like "his body" became distracting and detracted from the narrative's sophistication. The pacing sometimes dragged, making the story feel like it was going through the motions without fully exploring its potential. Ultimately, I stopped reading-not out of frustration-but because the book didn't compel me to continue. While Fourth Wing may appeal to readers seeking fantasy and mature themes, it didn't quite deliver for me.
