How To Read EZGO Serial Numbers Unfortunately, EZGO golf carts have serial numbers that are notoriously difficult to read. EZGO has changed its serial number coding process a few times over the years and has also had a few years of model crossover (two different models being produced during the same years). As a result, using the serial number/manufacturing code is often an unreliable way of determining your make and model. Typically, we have most of our customers send us a few photos of their EZGO so we can use the body to identify what model they have. With all that being said, it is not impossible to extract some information from the manufacturing code. The last two digits of the manufacturer's code will tell you the year your cart was produced.
