It's called the Wisconsin 6 Cheese. It's headquartered in Denver, Colorado. That all said, there is a time and a place for Wisconsin 6 Cheese. Namely, that time and place is either when you're with a group of extremely picky eaters or when you have a bunch of toppings from home that you plan on adding to the top yourself. This specialty pizza faces the same identity problem as Wisconsin 6 Cheese. If you want a fast food pepperoni pizza with lots of pepperoni (or an "ultimate" amount of pepperoni, if you will), then why not just order extra pepperoni?
