This period is referred to as "Bro" by locals as the hottest months end with -bro in Portuguese: setembro, outubro, novembro, and dezembro. A peculiar feature of the rains in the city are their speed and intensity, with strong winds, large force of water and very common lightning. The annual rainfall stands at around 1,325 millimetres or 52 inches. The highest recorded daily precipitation was 125 millimetres (5 in).[7] Hot most of the year, Teresina has an average temperature around 27 °C or 80.6 °F, with a minimum of 20 °C or 53.4 °F in June, while the record hot temperature exceeds 40 °C or 104 °F (October and November). Annually, there are approximately 129.4 days in which the maximum daily temperature reaches or except in the driest period, when the relative humidity drops, and there are occurrences of fires.
