## Clobetasol 0.05% cream

### What is this medicine?

CLOBETASOL is a corticosteroid. It is used on the skin to treat itching, redness, and swelling caused by some skin conditions.

### What should my health care professional know before I take this medicine?

They need to know if you have any of these conditions:

- any type of active infection including measles, tuberculosis, herpes, or chickenpox
- circulation problems or vascular disease
- large areas of burned or damaged skin
- rosacea
- skin wasting or thinning
- an unusual or allergic reaction to clobetasol, corticosteroids, other medicines, foods, dyes, or preservatives
- pregnant or trying to get pregnant
- breast-feeding

### How should I take this medicine?

This medicine is for external use only. Do not take by mouth. Wash your hands before and after use. Apply a thin film of medicine to the affected area. Do not cover with a bandage or dressing unless your doctor or health care professional tells you to. Do not get this medicine in your eyes. If you do, rinse out with plenty of cool tap water. It is important not to use more medicine than prescribed. Do not use your medicine more often than directed. To do so may increase the chance of side effects.

Talk to your pediatrician regarding the use of this medicine in children. Special care may be needed.
