## Acetaminophen (Paracetamol) tablet

### What is this medicine?

ACETAMINOPHEN is a pain reliever. It is used to treat mild pain and fever.

### What should I tell my health care provider before I take this medicine?

They need to know if you have any of these conditions:

- if you frequently drink alcohol containing drinks
- liver disease
- an unusual or allergic reaction to acetaminophen, other medicines, foods, dyes or preservatives
- pregnant or trying to get pregnant
- breast-feeding

### How should I take this medicine?

Take this medicine by mouth with a glass of water. Take your medicine at regular intervals. Do not take your medicine more often than directed. The recommended maximum daily dose, for adults, is 4 grams.

Talk to your pediatrician regarding the use of this medicine in children. While this drug may be prescribed for children as young as 6 years of age for selected conditions, precautions do apply.

Overdosage: If you think you have taken too much of this medicine contact a poison control center or emergency room at once.

NOTE: This medicine is only for you. Do not share this medicine with others.

### What may interact with this medicine?

- alcohol
- imatinib
- isoniazid
- other medicines with acetaminophen
